**SENIOR HORSE, JUNIOR HORSE, AMATEUR OWNER, YOUTH, BEGINNER ADULT, BEGINNER YOUTH, IMPROVER, MINI, YEARLING/2YO, SELECT, ENGLISH HORSE,**

**PLEASENOTE::ALL COMPETITORS WISHING TO NOMINATE FOR THE Amateur/owner and SELECT AMATUER , NEED TO HAVE YOUR APPROPRIATE CARDS FROM THEIR RELEVANT BREED SOCIETY TO BE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE IN THESE EVENTS. This means that if you are riding an Appaloosa you will be required to have an AAA Amateur/Masters Card, Quarter Horse AQHA etc. All rules for eligibility are on the AQHA website.**

### **Select Amateur Permit (aqha Ruling)**

If a person has attained the age of fifty (50) years and provides proof of age, which must be in the form of a copy of a drivers licence or birth certificate, then their Amateur Permit will be endorsed as to allow them to compete in Select Amateur classes;

- ❖ When a show program offers Select Amateur classes and both Junior and Senior Amateur classes in Western Pleasure, Trail, Hunter Under Saddle, Western Riding and Reining, then a person with a Select Amateur Permit, may enter either the Junior Amateur or the Senior Amateur classes on a different horse to the one they ride in their Select class, as long as the age of horse rule applies and the Amateur, or their immediate family, own the horse.
- ❖ A horse will not be used more than once by the same competitor in any class. eg. A horse cannot compete in Select Amateur Trail and Senior Amateur Trail;
- ❖ A Select Amateur, choosing to compete in a Select class at a show, is not confined to the other Select Amateur classes at that show. Eg. A person who competes in the Select Amateur Hunter Under Saddle can compete in the Amateur Hunt Seat Equitation on the same horse;
- ❖ The person applying for this Permit must be a financial member of the Association and hold an individual membership in their own name, either a Full, Life, Hon. Life Membership;
- ❖ The person applying for the permit must declare the following: "I have not, in the previous three (3) years from the date of application for my Permit, received remuneration or compensation for: Showing or training any horse or instructed any other person in riding, driving or exhibiting." NB: You cannot show in an Amateur/Select Amateur class until such time as your application is successful and been processed.

### As from the 1st August 2012 the following rules apply

No alcohol is allowed in, or can be consumed in the marshaling areas, working arenas or show pen/contest areas. Competitor's/participants at any event run by TOP END WESTERN HORSE CLUB have a responsibility to ensure the welfare of their horses and at all times to treat their horses humanely and with dignity, respect and compassion. Competitors/participants are to conduct themselves in a professional manner and act with integrity in all dealings with the Affiliate and other competitors. To uphold the rules and regulations of the TOP END WESTERN HORSE CLUB and the AQHA at all times.

Competitors/participants are to demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times, showing respect for your fellow competitors and officials, following the rules and to treat people the way you yourself wish to be treated.

All youth competing or taking part in an AQHA approved event, must have written permission from their parent/guardian to be at that event as a contestant or participant and in the case of a contest, the parent/guardian must also sign the entry form. All youth competing or taking part in an AQHA approved event, must be in the care of a responsible adult who is in attendance for the duration of that event, whilst the youth is in attendance at that event.

**PLEASE NOTE THAT THE WESTERN RIDING REQUIRES THE COMBINATION TO SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE 3 FLYING CHANGES OR THEY WILL BE ELIMINATED.**

### **DIVISION CATEGORIES:**

**SENIOR HORSE:** Horses 6yrs & over as of 1<sup>st</sup> August. (Must be bridled)

**JUNIOR HORSE** Horses 5yrs & under as of 1<sup>st</sup> August.

**AMATUER/OWNER:** Must hold a current Amateur/Owner card with the relevant breed society.

**YOUTH:**aged 3 years to 18 years of age as of 1st August of the preceding year; and a) The minimum age for a youth competing in any Open class or Youth ridden classes, is 7 yrs old, exception Rule 63.15 and 63.16; and b) The minimum age for a Youth competing in Youth Showmanship and Youth Halter is five (5) years of age and Open Halter classes is seven (7) years of age and over.

### **IMPROVER:**

- \* Is a transitional event only
- \* Horse and Rider combinations can only acquire 5 wins in a particular event.
- \* Horse, Rider combinations who have/are leaving Junior Horse and are not ready for Senior Horse can participate for 5 shows then must move forward.
- \* Any other combination other than above cannot have competed in any Open type events
- \* Combinations will be expected to do all paces as per pattern posted for that particular event
- \* Can be ridden 2 handed in a snaffle or Bit but must remain how you start in each event.
- \* Riders can be youth or adult.
- \* Points are only allocated per show and do not count for End Of Year Hi Point
